<u>Aggression</u> – any offensive action or attack

**Decisive** – to be able to make choices quickly and confidently

<u>Confederate</u> - a soldier, citizen, or supporter of the Confederacy (The South) during the American Civil War

<u>Union</u> - group of northern states that supported the federal government during the American Civil War

<u>Strategy – the skill of making or carrying out plans to achieve a goal</u>

**<u>Defensive –</u>** protecting someone or something from attack

<u>Flanking – to be located on both sides of (something or someone)</u>

**Overrun** – to enter and be present in (a place) in large numbers

**<u>Invincible –</u>** impossible to defeat or overcome, unbeatable

**Combat** – active fighting especially in a war

**Reinforce** – to strengthen (a group of people) with new supplies or more people

<u>Casualties –</u> a person who is hurt or killed during an accident, war, etc.

**Execute** – to do something that you have planned to do or been told to do, carry-out
